



Notes: GTN

- **Complete mole**

- Diploid (androgenic origin)
- Usually due to duplication of haploid sperm following fertilization of an empty ovum
- No fetal tissue
- Always surgical evacuation as no fetal tissues

- **Partial mole**

- Triploid - Two sets of paternal genes and 1 set of maternal
- Usually due to dispermic fertilization of an ovum
- evidence of fetus or RBCs.
- Medical evacuation may be necessary if large fetal tissues
